Number of buildings and type.

- Five Elementary Buildings, one middle school, one high school, and one alternative learning center
 - Avilla Elementary, located in Avilla. Enrollment: 428 students in grades PK-5. Avilla houses the district's preschool in a unique active experiential learning environment.
 - North Side Elementary, located in Kendallville. Enrollment: 292 students in grades K-5.
 - Rome City Elementary, located in Rome City. Enrollment: 240 students in grades K-5.
 - South Side Elementary, located in Kendallville. Enrollment: 314 students in grades K-5.
 - Wayne Center Elementary, located in Kendallville. Enrollment: 346 students in grades K-5.
 - East Noble Middle School, located in Kendallville. Enrollment: 782 in grades 6-8.
 - East Noble High School, located in Kendallville. Enrollment: 1057 in grades 9-12.
 - Alternative Learning Center, located in Kendallville. Capacity is 50 secondary students.

Building level administrators (include assistant principals)

- Seven Principals lead the seven buildings.
- Two assistant principals at the high school, one assistant principal at the middle school,
- One full time dean of students in each of two elementary buildings and a half time dean of students in each of three elementary buildings.
- One Director of the Alternative Learning Center who reports to the high school principal.
