
Union County College Corner Joint School District is located in Liberty, Indiana. Union County is in east central Indiana on the border with Ohio. It consists of four schools: Liberty Elementary School, College Corner Union Elementary School, Union County Middle School, and Union County High School. Union County College Corner Joint School District is also affiliated with the Whitewater Career Center, which offers 13 career programs for high school juniors and seniors.

The schools have an enrollment of approximately 1,300 students, serving preschool-12th grade students. Union County College Corner Joint School District is unique in the fact that College Corner Union Elementary School is located in both Indiana and Ohio. The state line runs directly through the school's gymnasium. The current school district boundaries encompass all of Union County, Indiana, a portion of Franklin County, Indiana, and portions of Butler and Preble Counties in Ohio. The district is governed by a nine person Board of School Trustees, with Indiana and Ohio representation and operate under the laws of the State of Indiana. UCCCJSD schools offer a broad range of academic and extra-curricular programs and are blessed with highly qualified teachers and staff that care deeply about the children they serve.

The Community

Union County is primarily an agricultural community and supports many small businesses and manufacturers including D & L Finishes and NSK America, Inc.

Tourists flood the area during the summer months to enjoy camping, fishing and boating, hiking, biking, and horseback riding at Whitewater Memorial State Park. Whitewater Lake is headwaters of the Brookville Lake Reservoir, which counts Quakertown Beach in Union County as a popular swimming spot. In the summer and fall there are festivals, farmers' markets, and celebrations on the town square.

The school district is conveniently located near major airports, professional sports teams, and major medical health centers. Union County is also conveniently located 65 miles from Cincinnati, Ohio to the south, Dayton, Ohio to the east, and Indianapolis, Indiana to the west. Miami University in Oxford, Ohio and Indiana University East and Ivy Tech, located in nearby Richmond, Indiana are within 20 minutes of Liberty and offer higher education and career opportunities.
